Antelope Public Facilities Financing Plan Development Impact Fee Program Groundwater Mitigation Fee

Brief description of the type of fee in the fund:

The Antelope groundwater mitigation development impact fee was established to partially offset the costs that would be incurred by a water purveyor for extending water lines through the Poker Lane and Lewis Avenue areas, which would enable residents of the Central Subarea of the East Antelope Specific Plan to connect at their own expense to water supply facilities.
